



About the location:

Cartuja Center CITE is located at Leonardo da Vinci Street, 11 Sevilla 41092 in the heart of the Isla de la Cartuja, where you can also find the UIA project, CartujaQanat, based. Today, Isla de la Cartuja is considered the cultural district of the city, and it is largely because Cartuja Center CITE is located in it.

The Isla de la Cartuja, hosted in 1992 the Universal Exhibition of Seville and was known and valued for its innovative infrastructures around the world. To this day, it continues to maintain that avantgarde spirit that marked an era in the city.

Likewise, the Isla de la Cartuja is located a short distance from the center of Seville. It also has





hotel, commercial and leisure services within the island and public transport stops in the vicinity of Cartuja Center.

Travelling by car

Travelling by train

Santa Justa train station is Seville's main train station, offering regular services to destinations all over the region. The Santa Justa train station is located to the north-east of the city centre, on Avenida Kansas City. The train station is about 4km away from the event location, easily reachable by several different modes of transport, most convenient by bus (see bus lines below).

Travelling by plane

Seville Airport (or San Pablo airport) is located 10 kilometres (6 miles) east of downtown Seville and 110 kilometres (68 miles) north-east of Costa de la Luz.

From Seville Airport to city center:

By Bus: Buses operate at Seville Airport from 05:20 am to 01:15 am approximately. Trip time is approximately 35 minutes.

By Taxi: Travel time to Seville city centre is about 15 minutes. More information here.

From Seville Airport to Cartuja Center CITE:

By bus: There are buses every 15 minutes from the airport to the event location. Click <u>here</u> for more info.

By car: It is around a 20-minute drive from the airport to the event location via highway E-5/A-4. Click here for more info.

Accommodation

UIA has an agreement with <u>Eurostars</u> including <u>Gaudalquivir</u> and <u>Exe Macarena Hotels</u>. Please use the code: <u>UIAQANAT</u> or <u>IAC</u> in the promotional code section should you wish to book your stay in one of these locations. The code is valid until 15 days before arrival (04/12). In case of a cancellation, you must make sure to cancel at least 7 days before the arrival data otherwise the total amount of the stay will be charged by the hotel.

COVID-19 RELATED INFORMATION:

The health and safety of all participants is our number one priority. Therefore, we are implementing the following Covid-19 safety measures with safety distancing, hygiene protocols and fitted masks to be worn during the event.

Step 1 Before your trip

For traveling to and entering Spain from another country, all persons are required to have a valid EU digital COVID Certificate or present a negative certificate of a PCR-Antigen test carried out within 72 hours prior to arrival. The Rapid antigen detection tests (RAT) can be carried out within 24 hours prior to arrival in Spain. The accepted tests are those approved by the European Commission, which can be found here.

There are currently 29 EU/EEA countries on the Spanish 'risk' list, which is updated weekly here. When travelling by airplane, all persons should complete the Health Control Form and obtain a QR code to present at boarding and health controls on arrival in Spain. This form must be completed and sent to health authorities 48 hours before the flight. A QR code will be sent to your email shortly after in order to show during boarding and when passing through health control at the destination airport. It must be accessible on your mobile phone or printed out.

The use of mask is mandatory in public transport. If you experience any symptoms (fever, cough, shortness of breath) prior to your trip in the last 14 days, please make sure to not follow through with any travel arrangements.

Step 2 – During your stay

Once in Seville, Spain, some places may need you to show proof of vaccination to enter accommodation or other venues. The EU Covid pass is eligible for this as well as complete vaccination schemes (the administration of a booster vaccination). In case of a complete vaccination schedule, you should check for validity periods.

From 1 February 2022, this certificate will be valid from 14 days after the administration of the last dose of the complete vaccination schedule and will be valid up to 270 days from the administration of this last dose. Thereafter, in order to be valid, the vaccination certificate must reflect the administration of a booster dose. These certificates will be considered valid from the day the booster dose is administered. For a vaccination schedule of 3 shots, the EU covid pass has unlimited validity.

Masks are no longer compulsory in Spain. Unless in a crowded place where 1.5 distance cannot be kept, it is encouraged to wear a mask.

Please note that these health safety measures might change according to new government rules. We will inform you accordingly should any changes occur in this regard.

COVID-19 Safety Measures at Cartuja Center Cite

There are certain sanitary measures put in place to be followed by all attendees in order to maintain a safe and healthy environment for all. Please read carefully all the related information below to follow during the event.

Cleaning and disinfection of the facilities

- All the facilities of the event venue are kept clean and disinfected.
- The facilities where the event will take place will be disinfected before and after the event.

Access to the event venue

- You must arrive at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the event.
- Access to the venue will be carried out in stages out by security guards of the company EULEN SEGURIDAD, who will guarantee compliance with all the established health standards.
- To access the event space, an individual temperature measurement without contact will be carried out by the security service of the center.
- Access to the Cartuja Center CITE space requires is all personnel and attendees who access the space to wear a mask. If you don't have a mask, we will provide you with one.
- You will have at your disposal various points of supply of hydroalcoholic gel distributed throughout the building.
- Maintain the indicated safety distance at all times.
- Please move around the premises along the established lanes and directions to avoid crowds in common areas.

Toilets

- The toilets will have limited capacity to avoid crowds.
- Continuous cleaning and disinfection will be carried out.

Elevators

- The use of elevators is reserved preferably for people with reduced mobility or special needs.
- The number of occupants per cabin is 1 person.

Circulation through the venue

- The planning of the movement of all attendees and the distribution of spaces will be organized to guarantee the interpersonal safety distance and avoid crowds
- Signalling elements have been installed with indications about directions and circulation flows as well as on the safety distance

Evacuation

- As with access to the premises, an exit will be made to avoid crowds.
- It will be carried out in stages.
- It will be done through the nearest emergency exit.
- Please wait in your seats to receive instructions from the room staff.
